

# We Need Volunteers



The Rai\$ing Race 2, an *Amazing Race* type fund-raiser that benefits Leslie's Cottage at Calvary Home for Children, is scheduled for August 24 - 26, 2006, in Upstate, South Carolina. This year promises to be bigger and even more exciting than last year. That means more volunteers will be needed. Most of the filming this year is covered, but we still need team monitors and task monitors in all upstate counties.



As a team monitor, you will follow a team through the various tasks and clues, assuring that Rai\$ing Race rules and local laws are observed. Being a team monitor requires a certain amount of physical activity.



As a task monitor, you will set up and monitor the various tasks. Monitors must be at least 15 years of age unless accompanied by a parent. You may volunteer for one day, part of a day or all days. You may volunteer in only one upstate county or "float" in any or all counties. "Floating" will give you access to observe more of the race.



Volunteers will be required to attend one of several volunteer meetings that will be held in the upstate (dates and locations TBA). There is a \$15 fee which covers your official Rai\$ing Race volunteer t-shirt, Finale Celebration ticket, and BBQ meal at the party. Celebrities from *Amazing Race* and *Survivor* will be on-hand for pictures and autographs.
